The product became known as SEALTIGHT in 1930 and a knight in armor – SIR SEALTIGHT – was adopted as the company's image.



From the beginning, W. R. MEADOWS, INC. was determined to play a leadership role in the concrete construction industry. The company built a reputation for quality, integrity and service among architects, engineers and contractors in the construction industry and is known today for its broad line of high performance, premium grade construction products for use in, on, around and under concrete.

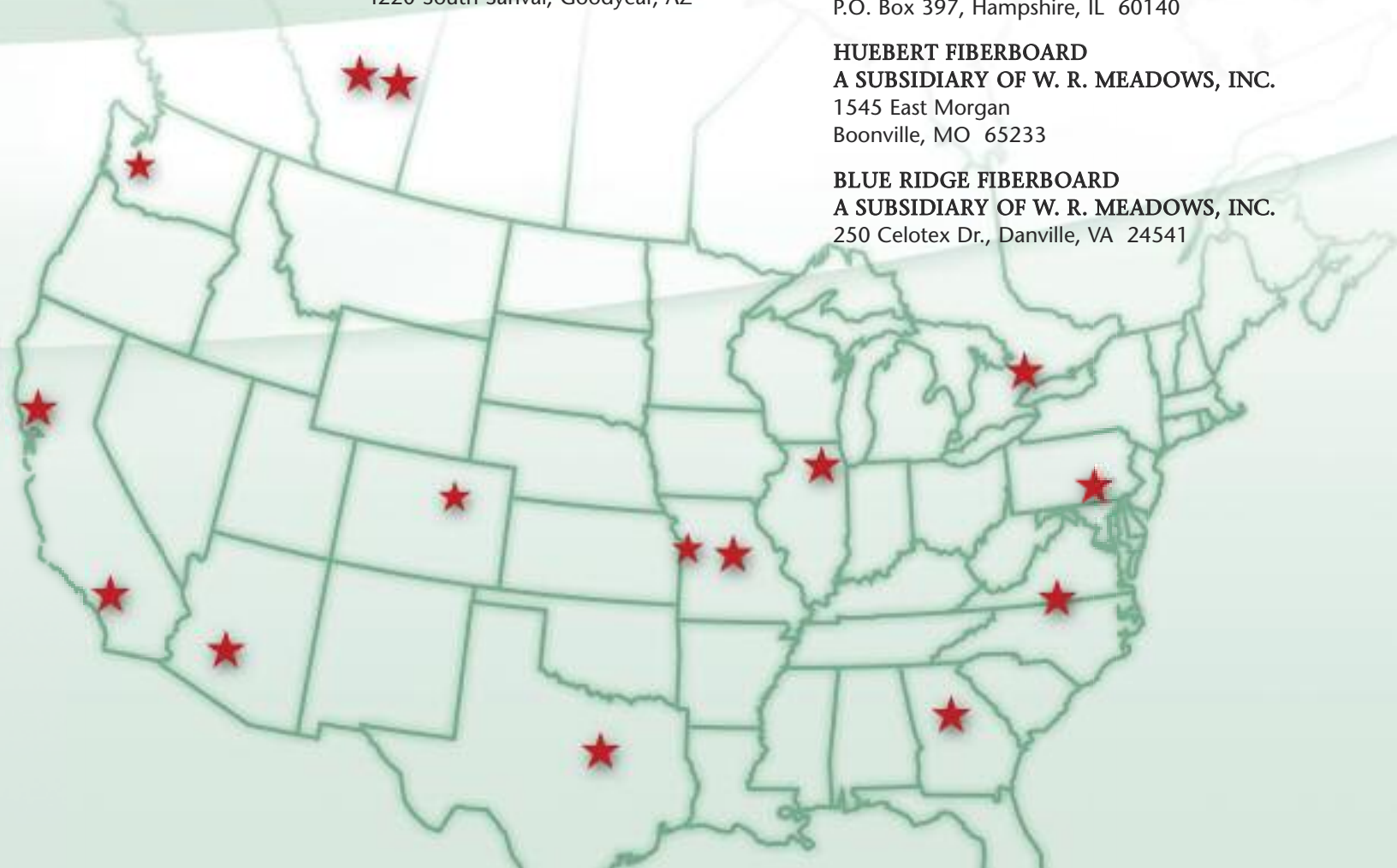
